Punishable Ingredients of Ragging

- o Abetment to ragging.
- o Criminal conspiracy to rag.
- o Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging.
- o Violation of decency and morals through ragging.
- o Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt.
- o Wrongful restraint.
- o Wrongful confinement.
- o Use of criminal force.
- o Assault, as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences.
- o Extortion, criminal trespass.
- o Offences against property.
- o Criminal intimidation.
- o Attempt to commit any or all of the mentioned offences against the victims(s).
- o Physical or psychological humiliation.

Punishments

- o Suspension from attending classes & academic privileges.
- o Withholding/ withdrawing scholarships/ fellowship and other benefits.
- o Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- o withholding results.
- o Debarring from representing the Institute in any regional, national or international meet, tournament youth festival etc.
- o Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- o Cancellation of admission.
- o Rustication from the Institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
- o Expulsion from the Institutional and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- o Fine ranging between Rs. 25,000 to Rs. 1 Lakh.
- o An F.I.R will be lodged against the culprit(s) as per Supreme Court of India & MHRD directives.
